The Kudzu Clinics are a service offered to members of GDCTA. In the spirit of improving the skills of our members and their horses about four times each year riding instructors and barns donate their time and facilities toward a low key but high quality instructional experience. The third Kudzu Clinic in the 2010 series will be a bit different from the usual fare. Johnny and Marissa Woodall of Miracle Music Freestyles have volunteered their time to help GDCTA members with their musical freestyle aspirations. The day will follow the progression with which riders develop a musical freestyle. The morning will deal with the basics: tempo, gait analysis, how to determine the beat of a musical selection. In addition to instructional material, we will be accepting up to four riders who are that this stage of development in their musical freestyle and are looking for assistance in "getting started." The afternoon will be spent working on the more advanced concepts of choreography, presentation, etc. Toward that end we are looking for three riders with patterns they want to ride with or without music. The day will end with a "putting it all together ride" by Christina Boyd on Navaro. Christina has been working with Marissa and Johnny and by all accounts this is one dynamite musical freestyle.
